The Department of Foreign Affairs wishes to inform your office that the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan is inviting concerned parties to express interest for consultancy services to market wind energy. The Ministry, in particular, is in need of three (3) consultants to undertake the projects indicated hereunder:

1. A consultant for the National Electric Power Company to determine the technical requirements to connect the projects of renewable energy with the electric network;
2. A consultant for the Electricity Regulatory Commission to improve the legal, regulatory and institutional frameworks necessary for the development of renewable energy resources in Jordan; and
3. A consultant for the Electricity Regulatory Commission to put a guiding price list for the electric tariff, for various types of renewable energy.

The Philippine Embassy in Jordan has requested the Ministry to provide information on the nature, scope, time frame, and framework of the consultancy services it requires to better appreciate which Philippine consulting firms, if any, should be most appropriate to approach for their requirements.

In the meantime, the Department of Energy is requested to disseminate the information to parties who may be interested in the consultancy services of Jordan.
