

**ENERGY SPOT CHECK  
PARTIAL CUMULATIVE ELECTRICITY & FUEL SAVINGS FROM  
SEPTEMBER 2005 TO MAY 2008**

- The government was able to save **Php 1,009,379,074.00**. (Php 853,186,142.00 in electricity and Php156,192,932.00 in fuel) from September 2005 to May 2008. This was based from the 120 government agencies in the National Capital Region and 200 agencies from different regions submitting monthly consumption report.
  - The DOE is continuously conducting spot check of government agencies nationwide.
  - From September 2005 to September 2006, 76 agencies in Metro-Manila, 9 in Region I, 25 in Region III, 7 in Region V, 15 in Region VI, 22 in Region VII, 30 in Region X, 29 in Region XI and 10 in Region XII were spot checked.
  - The second round of spot check started in April 2008. The audit team has visited 42 government agencies in Metro Manila, 22 in Region 1, 20 in Region III, and 24 in Region VI. Other Regions will be visited until August 2008.
- The enercon measures implemented are the ff:

**Electricity**

1. Operating aircon for six hours only (i.e.9:00 AM to 4:00 PM)
2. Setting of aircon to fan during lunch time (12:00 NN - 1:00 PM)
3. Maintaining room temperature not lower than 25 °C
4. Replacing incandescent bulbs with Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFL) and 40W fluorescent lamps with 36W or 32W slim type fluorescent lamps.
5. Turning off of lights from 12:00 NN - 1:00 PM
6. Turning off of computers/office equipment/appliances when not in use

**Fuel**

1. Regular preventive maintenance of all vehicles.
2. Retiring old and inefficient vehicles.
3. Scheduling of trips.
4. Reduction of fuel allocation for each vehicle by 10%.
