◆ **FACTS (current Energy settings in the Philippines)**

- Energy Intensity (Industry Sector) – 2nd to Vietnam
- Energy Intensity (Commercial Sector) – 5th to Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia and Chinese Taipei
- No Energy Conservation Law
 - Japan, Thailand, Vietnam, India, China and Malaysia already have their own Energy Conservation Law while Indonesia's is on-going
 - Japan have already amended their Energy Conservation Law 5x and Thailand by 2x
- No Energy Technology and Management Center
 - ◆ Malaysia (PTU)
 - ◆ Vietnam (ECCU)
 - ◆ Thailand (ECCT)
 - ◆ Indonesia (KONEBA)
- No Energy Conservation Fund
 - Financial support and subsidy for Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EE&C) Programs for industrial/commercial sectors
 - Thailand's Energy Conservation Fund comes from their oil tax

◆ **ENPAP ADVOCACY**

- Passage of the Energy Conservation Bill to Law
 - Institutionalize:
 - Energy Manager for 1 MW and above (compulsory)
 - Targets for the industrial/commercial/transport/residential sector
 - Energy Management Center
 - Energy Conservation in primary and secondary educational system
 - Promote energy efficient products and equipments – Energy Labeling (Energy Star top runner)
- Information, Education and Communication campaign for Energy Efficiency and Conservation – Don Emilio Abello
