2.	Retail Outlets with other merchandise	Maximum aggregate quantity of LPG stored inside the establishment is 110 kgs for all brands and sizes.	Refers to a natural or juridical person involved in the sale of LPG in cylinders directly to end consumers, having a maximum aggregate quantity of LPG stored inside the establishment is 110 kgs for all brands and sizes.
		Maximum aggregate quantity of LPG less than 1kg stored inside the establishment is 110 kgs for all brands.	Refers to a natural or juridical person involved in the sale of LPG less than 1kg directly to end consumers, having a maximum aggregate quantity of LPG stored inside the establishment is 110 kgs for all brands (40 crates of 12 pcs).
