**AGREEMENTS MADE DURING THE MEETING AMONG THE DOE  
REPRESENTATIVES AND RE DEVELOPERS ON LAND RIGHTS ISSUES**

Please be advised that in a meeting held on 3 November 2017 among the DOE representatives and RE Developers, the following were agreed upon to address land rights issues:

1. For pending RESC applications, including the pre-qualified and pre-signed, the RE Developers shall be required to sign an Affidavit of Undertaking which states that:
  - i. For private lands, RE Developers shall submit within six (6) months, from 3 November 2017 for those who attended the meeting, or from date of REMB advisory posted in the DOE website for those who were not present, proof of ownership or possessory rights over the real property/ies covered by the Contract Area;
  - ii. For public lands, submit within the same period, proof of application to acquire ownership or secure possessory rights over the real property/ies covered by the Contract Area; and
  - iii. For applied area, RESC applications shall no longer conform to the blocking map system. Instead, RESC Developers shall be required to submit the exact coordinates of their applied areas as an attachment to their respective Letters of Intent.
2. For new RESC applications, the DOE shall issue a Department Circular wherein proof of land ownership/rights shall be required at the preliminary stage of the application process.
